Development Update

ADCO Constructions has commenced work on the Branch Library and Community Resource Centre. The \$12M facility will be

built over the next twelve months and when completed will provide another exciting addition to Oran Park Town and the wider Camden community.

Parks

Civil works to Champions Park, which is located at The Northern Road entrance to Oran Park are now complete with landscaping underway. The park will be located on both sides of Peter Brock Drive with dog off-leash park, wetlands, walkways, viewing platforms and grassed kickabout spaces.

The final stages of Grand Prix Park, located on Peter Brock Drive, are nearing completion with the final stage to be opened to the public in March 2017.




eastern side of Oran Park Drive between north of "Hollywood" sign and Kolombo Creek.

Part of the Stage 3 works is to embellish the riparian corridor and provide a few break out spaces and pedestrian shareways along Kolombo Creek. There will be seating, shelter & picnic opportunities and fitness stations along the creek line & water quality basin areas. The pedestrian shareway & footpath network continues to grow in Oran Park Town and provide the community a walkable environment.

We now have a staged development consent approval for Tranche 29 Stage 2 east of the Town Centre. The approval is for 72 residential lots and construction of part of Dick Johnson Drive.

We also have lodged three development applications for sections of Dick Johnson Drive north of Tranche 21 connecting Steward Drive and South Circuit (west) and north of the future Town Centre between Oran Park Drive & South Circuit (near Camden Council). The proposal includes connection of Oran Park Drive to Jack Brabham Reserve which will allow better traffic movements and connections around the Oran Park Public School and to Jack Brabham sporting oval. At this stage we are seeking DA approvals and timing is subject to statutory approvals. Further updates will be provided to residents.

Construction Update

Civil works to the medium density site within Tranche 7, located adjacent to Oran Park Public School, have commenced and are expected to be completed by the middle of 2017.

Construction of the terrace sites within Tranche 1, located between the Child Care and NewLife Anglican Church has commenced with works programmed to be finished mid-2017.

Placement of the second layer of bitumen has been ongoing throughout various stages within the project. We would like to thank everyone for their cooperation during these works.

Registration

Tranche 10 Stage 4 (Lots 601 -673) was registered by the Land and Property Information in early March 2017 and we look forward to the commencement of homes within this area.

New Parking Restrictions

Council's Traffic Committee have recently approved new parking restrictions for the Oran Park Town Centre namely along Peter Brock Drive as well as a section of Oran Park Drive in the vicinity of the Oran Park Sales and Information Centre, Great Beginnings Child Care and Oran Park Anglican College.

The unposted sections of road will now be "No Stopping" zones similar to other sections of Oran Park Drive and Peter Brock Drive. The restrictions will assist traffic movement in that area and will improve sight lines at intersections at Central Avenue & South Circuit. Residents are advised that these restrictions are now in place and any parking for the childcare and school pickup and drop off shall

be off local street network and **not** Peter Brock Drive.

Traffic Lights


We also wish to advise residents that formal approvals from the Roads and Maritime Services (RMS) are still pending. Camden Council have completed their design review and civil approvals will follow shortly after RMS signal approvals for the installation of the traffic signals at the following intersections:

- Oran Park Dr & Dan Cleary Dr
- Peter Brock Dr & Central Ave
- Peter Brock Dr & South Cct

We will provide further information once approval has been received.

Flu Vaccine

Influenza (flu) is a highly contagious viral infection that spreads easily from person to person through coughing, sneezing and close contact.

The flu virus can be especially dangerous for elderly people, pregnant women and people with underlying medical conditions.

Annual vaccination is the best way of preventing the flu and any associated illness and it's recommended that people get the flu shot every year to protect themselves from the constantly changing flu virus.

The 2017 flu shot will be available in April from doctor's surgeries and other immunisation providers.

Some people may be eligible for a free vaccine - please speak to your pharmacist or doctor to see if you're eligible.


